Subject: Bunkhouse Reassignment for Jim Groom

Dear Sirs,

Based upon the recent comments and activities of one camper, Jim Groom, we are recommending that CVI leadership approve a bunkhouse reassignment. We recommend that Mr. Groom be sequestered in a new bunkhouse, to be referred to as **Bunkhouse X** until further notice.

Furthermore, we recommend that he be assigned counselor responsibilities for this new house. Mr. Groom has begun to challenge the authority of the counselors in his existing house. We believe that this behavior suggests that he possesses strong leadership skills (and his previous involvement in DS106 supports this conclusion). We are hopeful that by providing him with a “leadership” role, he will be able to more appropriately channel his activities at Camp.

That said, we also recommend that his new bunkhouse be cordoned off on a special island that we have set aside at the campgrounds (we are readying it now). This will allow us to more easily monitor his behavior and ascertain that the move is reinforcing positive leadership qualities in him.

This approach also provides us with a solution to another developing challenge: the late arrival of a number of new campers whom we cannot easily continue to add to existing bunkhouse communities. We have noted that Mr. Groom craves the opportunity to lead new members of DS106, and as the sole, lead counselor in Bunkhouse X, he will be able satisfy this personal craving.

Please advise us ASAP as to whether you approve this recommendation. We are anxious to solve this problem before it becomes more difficult to contain.
